Equipped with integrated imaging and motion management capabilities, the system adapts in real-time to patient movement, making it especially effective for treating cancers in the lungs, breast, liver, and abdomen. It also supports advanced radiotherapy techniques such as Intensity-Modulated Radiotherapy, Image-Guided Radiotherapy, RapidArc®, and Stereotactic Radiosurgery, enabling doctors to tailor treatment to each individual's condition.

"As we dedicate the new Varian TrueBeam LINAC, we are reminded that our true strength lies not in technology alone, but in the compassion and unity we bring to every patient's journey," said Ms Diona Teh. "My father's legacy lives on in every act of care, every story of survival, and every step forward we take together."
