Student loses RM13,000 in Macau scam

KUANTAN: A female student, 23, lost RM13,000 to a Macau scam syndicate. State police commercial Crime Investigation Department chief Superintendent Mohd Wazir Mohd Yusof said the victim received a phone call from a woman who introduced herself as “Sergeant Salina”. “She alleged the victim was involved in money laundering and that her identity card was misused. Two other suspects, ‘Inspector Mohd Zulkifli’ and ‘Datuk Nizam’, were involved. She was asked to cooperate if she did not want to be detained,” he said yesterday. The victim handed over details of her card to “Datuk Nizam” for vetting. “The victim received a call from the bank, informing her that a large money transfer transaction had been made. She checked her account and found that RM13,000 had been withdrawn.”
