Woman loses more than RM160,000 in scam

KUANTAN: A private company employee in Bera, about 157km from here, has lodged a police report that she lost RM168,030 after she was duped by a non-existent money lending company since last month. Pahang Commercial Crime Investigation Department chief Superintendent Mohd Wazir Mohd Yusof said the woman claimed she came across an advertisement on social media and fell for it as it displayed the name of a local bank. Wazir said she was directed to make several payments for bank administration fee as well as other fees into five separate accounts from the end of May until last Wednesday. The victim only realised she had been duped when she was asked for more money although the loan had yet to be approved. **Bernama**
