This initiative has benefitted over 8,000 businesses since 2020.

The #JomBiz Programme is a collaboration with Taylor's

It holds workshops to help build micro-entrepreneurs' capabilities in business strategy, digitalisation, business pitching and financial literacy, and also provides seed funding for growth.

The initiative has benefitted more than 170 MSMEs, with additional opportunities opening up this year.
